The effect of a light-heat stimulus on the dustbathing behaviour of red Burmese junglefowl. – 1992. – Thesis

Note: The present study sought to test the suggestion advanced by Vestergaard, Hogan, Kruijt (1990) and others (Hein, 1970) that sunlight can induce dustbathing in red Burmese junglefowl. Red Burmese junglefowl were exposed to a light-heat stimulus for a period of one hour at one of three times during a regular 12 hour light:12 hour dark schedule. The duration, frequency and distribution of dustbathing was found to be significantly affected by the light-heat stimulus. The time of day during which the stimulus was presented also had an effect on the strength of the birds dustbathing response, so that birds exposed to the stimulus at noon responded much more vigorously than those shown the same stimulus either before or after noon. The effect of the light-heat stimulus on the basic cyclic pattern of dustbathing seemed to be balanced with the amount of dustbathing behaviour that occurred during the normal period. The system returned to a normal pattern of dustbathing one day after exposure to the light-heat stimulus, but it required two days to return to a normal level of dustbathing. The response to the light-heat stimulus was interpreted in terms of a hydro-mechanical model (Lorenz, 1950). (Abstract shortened by UMI.)
