Special Subject Collections in Germany

- System of national cooperative acquisition financed by the German Research Foundation (DFG)
- At least one copy of each academically relevant publication available in Germany
- Decentralized system instead of a National Library

Collection scope

- Countries: India, Pakistan, Nepal, Bhutan, Bangladesh,
 Sri Lanka, Maldives and Tibet (before 1950)
- Subjects: Languages and literatures, history, politics, geography, anthropology and sociology, art and art history, religion and philosophy

SSG 6,24 South Asia

- Special Subject Collection South Asia at Tübingen University Library from 1950 to 2004;
 app. 360.000 volumes, 800 manuscripts
- Since 2005 at the Library of the South Asia
 Institute; 265.000 volumes, 500 current periodicals



The publication platform offers free access to full-text documents and adheres to the principles of Open Access as well as the goals of the Budapest Open Access Initiative (BOAI).

People with a research interest in South Asia have the possibility to publish their work in electronic format and make it available through the World Wide Web. Thereby, SavifaDok quarantees long-term availability and visibility of your documents in library catalogues (e.g. KVK-Karlsruher Virtual Catalogue) and search engines by using standardized addresses and metadata. We publish books, articles and research papers as well as multi media documents.
